Physician Perks







Working as a physician at VCH comes with certain perks which can save you time, money, and stress! We have included some details below:

1. Free Access to UpToDate

As a VCH physician, you get a free subscription to UpToDate for clinic, hospital and mobile/home use. To activate your subscription:

- Access UpToDate by visiting www.uptodate.com from any VCH computer
- Click the Log In/Register button at the upper right corner of the screen



- Complete all fields on the registration page and click Submit Registration
- Upon completion of the registration process, you will receive a confirmation email from UpToDate with instructions to download the Mobile App, and/or to use the website from your personal device

2. College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC (CPSBC) Library

Through the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC (CPSBC) website, you can access a variety of educational materials:

- E-books/print books
- E-journals
- Point of care and drug tools
- Databases
- Apps and audiovisual
- Practice guidelines

The College librarian can also help with your literature searches. There is unlimited access to articles from the e-journal collection. The library staff provides 200 free journal articles per year. 3. Leadership Scholarship

Scholarships up to \$10,000 per year are available from the Specialist Services Committee (SSC) and the Shared Care Committee (SCC) to pursue leadership and quality improvement training activities. 4. Doctors of BC Benefits

Consider becoming a member of <u>Doctors of BC</u>! There are <u>multiple benefits</u> available to you upon joining, including access to practice support resources, insurance programs, billing tips, subscriptions to selected medical journals, and discounts on multiple travel, entertainment, and sporting events through the Club MD program.

Doctors of BC has also negotiated a number of benefits with the government of BC on physicians' behalf, including:

- The Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) Rebate Program for partial reimbursement of CMPA fees
- The Continuing Medical Education (CME) Fund, which assists physicians with educational expenses
- The Contributory Professional Retirement Savings Plan (CPRSP) provides funds to physicians for their retirement, and has a basic benefit component and a length of service component
- The Parental Leave Program provides income during a parental leave taken as a result of pregnancy, a surrogacy arrangement, or an adoption of a child
